

Entry Requirements: Open to all artists 18 years of age and over living in the United States. One entry - American representational. Recent work not previously exhibited with HVAA.

Media: Original oils, watercolors, graphics, sculpture and pastels. Photos, computer-assisted art, collages, classwork or mixed media not accepted. No illustrations.

Entry Fee: \$30 nonrefundable entry fee for nonmembers. Paid membership dues include entrance fee. No money orders will be accepted due to the Patriot Act.

Shipping Artwork: Details on shipping will be sent to all accepted artists.

Receiving All Hand-Delivered Work: Tuesday, June 29th, 2010, 10:00 A.M. - 2:00 P.M.

Sales: All art works are considered for sale unless listed NFS (not for sale) on entry card.

Liability: Entries will be handled with all possible care, but those submitting will be required to hold harmless the Hudson Valley Art Association and The National Arts Club, its agents, servants, and employees from any claim of damage that might arise from loss or damage from any cause whatsoever to the works of art submitted for the exhibition.

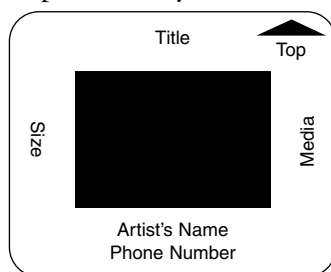
- Artwork not to exceed 42" in either direction, **INCLUDING FRAME**.
- No work smaller than 11"x14" not including frame (except graphics).
- Artwork must be framed (**no strip molding**), secured, and ready to hang.
- No oval frames.



Slides and jpegs will not be viewed if you have not signed the Catalog Card or members have not paid their dues.

Standard mount (no glass). Please label slides as indicated. Please print clearly. Use short titles.

Sculptors delivering their own work must provide the pedestal. A rental pedestal is available at a small fee to cover transporting from storage to gallery— by reservation only. A very small sculpture is not acceptable unless in a supplied case. Plaster or clay: walk-ins only. Shipped plaster or clay cannot be accepted.

JPEG FILE INSTRUCTIONS

The largest image dimension (width / height) should be 2400 pixels with the other dimension proportional.

- Save your images with a 300 dpi resolution as JPG
- Use JPG compression quality of 10.
- File size no larger than 1MB
- File name should be last name_first (doe_john.jpg)

* **Catalog Art Publication: MEMBERS ONLY** may submit one 5"x7" or 8"x10" **Color** or high resolution (Follow JPEG file instructions) digital file of artwork without frame for reproduction in the catalog. **NO COMPUTER INKJET PHOTOS ACCEPTED;** digital files are preferred. Photo need **NOT** be of show entry. All submissions are subject to printer approval. Cost to the artist is \$35, which will be refunded if work is not reproduced.
